- ❖ What are potential funding sources to address it?

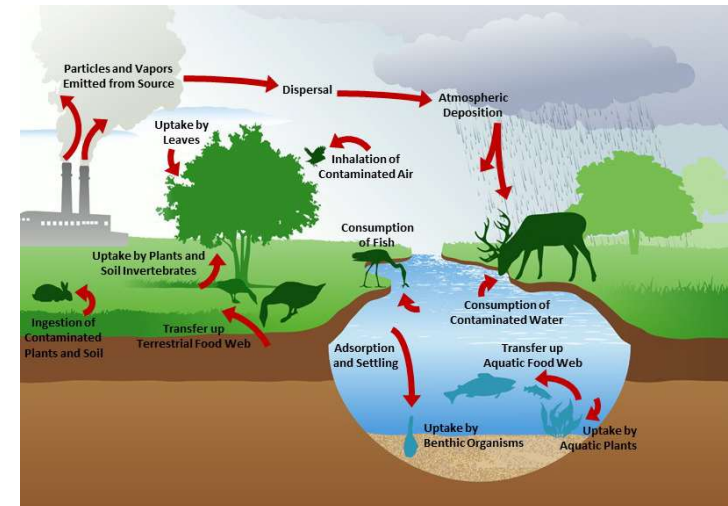

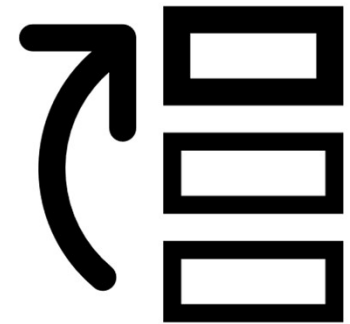
DEVELOP INTERIM SOLUTIONS
